The Freedom Walkway Local Heroes committee is seeking nominations of citizens who either today or in the past have:

- A. Live or lived in the Rock Hill/York County area (individuals or groups of individuals only; organizations are not eligible);**
- B. Played a significant role through advocacy or actions in promoting equality and justice for all citizens in the Rock Hill/York County area; and**
- C. Challenged community norms while demonstrating unselfish leadership, perseverance, and sacrifice, despite potential risk to reputation, livelihood, safety or even their lives.**
